

PARIS 2018

SQUASH REGULATION

I. Place, date and nature of the competition

The squash competition is going to be disputed on the grounds of the Paris Université Club (PUC), located in Charléty Stadium.

The games will take place from Monday 6th August to Friday 10 August.

The competition will have several tournaments depending on the level and gender (male and female).

Paris 2018 reserves the right to regroup into tournaments levels and / or genre depending on enrollment.

II. Categories

Several tournaments are organized according to the level of the players:

- A - International (Professional)
- B - Professional
- C - Confirmed
- D - Recreation, with competition experience
- E - Hobby, no experience in competition

III. Conditions for participation

Participation in the competition is subject to the submission:

- A license of the French Federation of Squash (for french participants only)
- OR a squash UFOLEP license with the mention "in competition" (for french participants only)
- OR a certificate authorizing the practice of squash in competition

Foreign athletes, even affiliated to the WSF, must provide a certificate (certificate types are available on the registration site) fitness to practice squash in competition.

Unlicensed participants will get a license from the French Squash Federation for the duration of the competition.

The participant unconditionally accepts these regulations.

IV. Sporting rules

The competition takes place in two stages. Each tournament has a group stage (of Monday, August 6 to Wednesday, 8 August) and finals (Wednesday, August 8 to Friday, August 10).

Group Games will take place over one day:

- Monday, August 6: A and C
- Tuesday, August 7: B, D and E

Paris 2018 reserves the right to modify these groups according to the number of participants.

Each participant will play 3 or 4 games best of 3 games (11 points with 2 points of difference).

The official rankings desk will be shown on Wednesday, August 8th. All participants will play the same number of games and come out in their classified level. You will preferentially convene two days following the following distribution:

- Wednesday, August 8: A and C
- Thursday, August 9: B, D and E
- Friday, August 10: A, B, C, D, E

Paris 2018 reserves the to modify this distribution according to the number of registered.

You will dispute 4-6 games best of 5 games (11 points, 2 points difference), depending on the number of registrations per level. All ranking games (last match in the competition) will be played on Friday.

To the extent possible, each player will have 1 day without competition during the week.

The organizing committee of PARIS 2018 reserves the right to change the schedule and organization of events in case of extreme necessity.

Sporting rules are those of the French Federation of Squash.

V. Convening

A first attendance letter will be transmitted to you for the first group match. Each player must report 20 minutes prior to his match schedule.

VI. Arbitration

A referee will direct the tournament. It will:

- Declare the beginning of the games

- Collect the scores and record them
- Enforce the game rules

The referee will have the ability to exclude any player.

Arbitration matches will be made by the two players that played previously in the field. It will be provided an arbitration sheet to deliver to the referee at the end of the match.

It is said that the competition has to take place peacefully, while respecting the propriety.

It also reminded that it is important to ensure the physical integrity of his opponent and to stop playing if risk.

VII. Ranking

Each tournament will reward the top three of the finalist for each category.

They will receive a gold, silver and bronze respectively in the first, second and
